As Year 6 enter their final term at Clinton, they will continue to revise for the SATs, as well as beginning some exciting, new ventures. Here is a brief outline of what they'll be up to ...

### Context for Learning and Writing

Thank you for your support during the children's inventions and to those who were able to attend the 'Dragons' Den' finale. It was most enjoyable and the children produced confident and persuasive pitches. This topic has led to much writing, during which there has been and will continue to be a strong focus on punctuation and spelling as the children must be able to use **all** punctuation accurately by the end of Year 6, and apply KS2 spelling patterns. Please support with this at home where possible.



### SATS

SATS will take place in the week beginning 8<sup>th</sup> May. The national timetable is as follows:

Monday 14 <sup>th</sup> May	Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling
Tuesday 15 <sup>th</sup> May	Reading
Wednesday 16 <sup>th</sup> May	Arithmetic Paper 1 and Maths Reasoning Paper 2
Thursday 17 <sup>th</sup> May	Maths Reasoning Paper 3

It is particularly important that your child sleeps well during these next weeks, SATs week in particular but also the following few weeks, as once the tests are done, the writing assessments will continue until the end of June. N.B. If your child wears glasses, please ensure they have them!

### PE

This will take place on a Tuesday and Friday afternoon, and will be games and dance (or swimming if chosen) respectively. Please ensure children have the appropriate kit – including hats and sun cream!



### Other subjects

Towards the end of the half-term, the children will be beginning their Business Enterprise project, which will be both educational and fun. Then, of course, the children will also be beginning auditions and rehearsals for the end of year production....watch this space!

### Homework Schedule

Tuesday – personalised spellings given out for spelling test the following Tuesday

Friday – Literacy and Maths homework given out (completed for the following Tuesday).
