

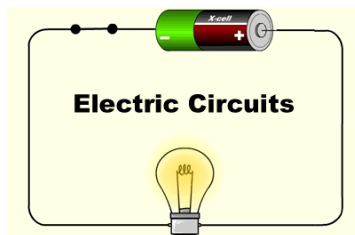
Dear Parents,

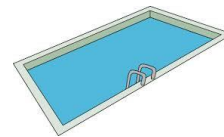


### Science
