SUN HEALTH

With the glorious weather we've been having, it's so important children wear sun-cream (the long lasting type – teachers can't apply it midway through the day). Children often have their lunch outside followed by PE, meaning 1.5 hours in the sun, potentially between 12.30 and 2 – the brightest part of the day. There are some year groups where every child has a hat, which is excellent, but others where we are starting to have to restrict where children can be because we don't want them getting burnt and endangering their future health.

INSTRUMENTAL TUITION PAYMENTS

We're about to add charges to your ParentPay accounts for all lessons apart from keyboard and steel pans. Spring term charges are based on actual lessons available from when each student signed up for online lessons. Payment for Spring term 2021 is due by 30th June. Summer Term charges are the usual charges of £80 for shared lessons and £125 for individual lessons (based on 11 lessons). Payment for Summer Term 2021 is due by 9th July 2021. If fewer than 11 lessons are available, refunds will be calculated at the end of this term. Please note there are no Summer term charges for cello lessons; this charge will be added if and when it is possible for cello lessons to resume.
