CENSUS DAY SCHOOL DINNER

Thank you for your support – we had an increase in KS1 children requesting a school dinner today. This really helps regarding the funding we will receive in the next academic year.

TALK LIKE AN EXPERT

It has been great popping into years 1 to 6 over the last week to hear children 'talking like an expert' about their science and history. This is something we're developing this year whereby children use visual reminders and key vocab that they learnt in a previous lesson to share their knowledge with a partner. It's led to them becoming really good at articulating their learning and sharing extra explanations and information with each other – rather than we teachers doing all the recapping! Ask them about it – and maybe they'll even share some of their learning with you! If you're lucky!

FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES

Warwickshire's Local Welfare Scheme is offering the following support to children eligible for benefits related FSM (Free School Meals).

Between 25th and 27th May 2022 - an automatic Huggs supermarket voucher for food support equivalent to £3 per day, £15 in total for the 5 day period covering the May half term school holiday.

Between 17th and 27th June 2022 - an automatic PayPoint cash voucher for £75 per household to be used towards energy costs

If your children are eligible for Free School Meals please do take a look at the attached letter.

In addition, the Local Welfare Scheme is also running a countywide fuel campaign from 20th June to 8th July 2022. We have also attached leaflets on the fuel campaign and other financial hardship support that is available.
